Vidovich has competed in the Elite Division Southwest series for several years. He won the championship in 2003, and finished second in 2000, 2001, and 2005. In 2005 Vidovich won the Toyota All-Star Challenge. At the end of the season, Vidovich tried out for Roush Racing's Craftsman Truck Series team in the TV show Driver X. Although not selected for the TV show, in the spring of 2006, Roush decided to hire Vidovich to run one truck race in place of driver David Ragan. And, midway through the 2006 season, Vidovich was signed to pilot the #4 Geico Dodge Charger for the Biagi Brothers in the Busch Series. Auggie signed a deal to drive an SRL car for the 2009 season and has signed with TCR Racing for the 2010 Camping World Series racing season. Vidovich is married with two children and currently resides in the San Diego, California area.
